# Principal's Message

From our Principal Mr Michael Gavaghan

Dear Parents & Carers,

I am writing from Adelaide, being the last stop of a pilgrimage led by the Sisters of St Joseph, that began on Monday at MacKillop College, Werribee and saw us travel via Hamilton, Portland, Penola to Adelaide. Lisa Black and I are travelling with 16 other pilgrims, some from Corpus Christi & MacKillop College in Werribee, while others are from as far away as Hastings on the Mornington Peninsula. I have developed a deeper appreciation of the story of Mary MacKillop and the work of her sisters, some of whom worked at St Andrew's across a span of some 80 years. We look forward to returning and sharing more of our journey with staff, students and school community. While we have been away the show has gone on and I am grateful to Glenn and the rest of the staff for giving us such a privileged opportunity.




















# What's your vision for Wyndham in 2050?
